

PQ&A with Madison Maupin the 2023 Tennessee Hereford Queen

What can you tell us about your background?

My name is Madison Maupin, and I live in Eagleville, Tennessee. I am a 2023 graduate of Eagleville School and a 2022 graduate of the Governor's School for Agricultural Sciences at The University of Tennessee at Martin. My family was always involved in agriculture, both row crop and livestock. My brother and I are at least 5th generation farmers on both sides of my family. In 2014, my parents branched out by starting our cattle operation with Angus and Charolais. We added our first Hereford-bred heifer in 2016. From that point forward, we were sold on Herefords and have been adding to our herd ever since. Today, I am the farm manager of Maupin Family Farms, where we specialize in commercial and registered Herefords and where I have started my herd of Hereford cattle.

How did you get involved in the Hereford industry?

I got involved in the Hereford industry when I was ten. My great-grandfather on my dad's side had raised Herefords but unfortunately had to downsize in the 80s and sold his herd. When we started in 2014, we purchased an assortment of beef cattle to determine which breed worked best for us. We began a partnership as L & M Farms and later focused on raising Hereford cattle as Maupin Family Farms. In 2018, we started moving our herd to Christiana, Tennessee, where we are today. I assist with all aspects of our operation, from daily care to AI, record keeping, and marketing. I am working on becoming USDA certified and getting my retail meat permit.

What is your favorite Hereford memory?

My favorite Hereford memory has to be when my bull, Vindicator, was born. Building my herd has been a slow process, but last year my first bull calf was born, and I have decided to keep him as an integral part of my herd's breeding program. Owning a registered Hereford bull is by far my greatest accomplishment to date.

What do you hope to accomplish as THA Queen?

Coming from a family that didn't necessarily have a large herd of cattle is a part of my story, so as the Tennessee Hereford Association Queen, I want to make it a point that no matter how many cattle or what a person's story is the Hereford breed is the place for them. The members of the Tennessee Hereford Association have been so incredibly kind and welcoming to my family, and I want to encourage others, young and old,

to join the Association because the Hereford breed is both a community and a family.

What are your future education and or career plans?

For my future plans, I will be attending The University of Tennessee at Martin this Fall, where I will be majoring in Animal Science and minoring in Agbusiness. In the coming years, I hope to relocate my herd to our family's farm in Newbern, Tennessee, which will allow me to work with them while enrolled in school at Martin. I want to pursue a Ph.D. in Animal Science and work in biotechnology while continuing to grow my herd.

THA FAMILY OF THE YEAR

The 2023 THA Family of the Year is Tommy and Kim Coley. Tommy is a Tennessee native with a rich history in the Hereford breed.

Tommy attended the first Coley Hereford production sale at two months of age. Throughout Tommy's childhood, his father, Clyde, and his uncle continued to grow and expand Coley Herefords. In the late 1960s, the Coley Hereford Bull Sale was recognized as one of the top 10 sales in the nation. When he reached high school, he was active in the Tennessee Junior Hereford Association, including serving as President. Tommy organized the first Tennessee Junior Field Day at Coley Herefords while serving as TJHA President.

He spent his youth working on the farm, playing football, and showing Herefords with his family. After graduation, Tommy went to The University of Tennessee in Knoxville. He was a member of Block and Bridle, the Livestock Judging Team, and the Farmhouse Fraternity. He recorded an individual high score on the judging team that lasted until about ten years ago.

While at UT Tommy met and married Sue Smith in 1973. Tommy and Sue moved to Ohio to manage Treeline Herefords after leaving the university. From there they made multiple moves across the country to different farms. The next move was back to West Tennessee to Sue's Family Farm in Jackson. Their son Matt and daughter Kristi were born there. After Jackson, they moved to Ashland City to manage Forman and Burris Herefords. When Forman and Burris split, they moved to Pembroke, Kentucky to establish Forman Herefords. They raised and showed several champions including the Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer in Denver at Forman Herefords.

Eventually, they left Forman's and moved to Rockford, Illinois to manage Perks Ranch. Tommy designed the current facility, laying the groundwork for a successful program. Tommy helped establish Perks as a Nationally recognized Hereford Breeder with National Champions and top selling bulls and heifers.

Sadly, after a long and courageous battle with breast cancer, Sue passed away in December 1996. Tommy and the kids had to go on alone until he met a single Mom named Kim Johnson, Kim had three children, Erin, Shea, and Will. Both families became one when Tommy and Kim married in 1998 and created a special bond. All the kids were athletic and loved showing cattle with the Perks children, Wade and Anna. Tommy coached the kids in softball, baseball, basketball, and football. The Coleys had a kid in high school for 11 years, which meant a lot of ball games. Tommy and Kim purchased several Red Angus from the Perks and moved them along with their Herefords and the family to Birmingham, Iowa after Cam Perks passed away. During this time Tommy had the honor of judging several National Shows including Louisville, Houston, San Antonio, and Ft. Worth. In 2009 he achieved a lifelong goal when he judged at Denver in 2009. He may be the only person in the country to show, win, judge, and work the show ring in Denver.

Twelve years ago, his dream job became available. The AHA Southeast Region Field Representative position was open. This is a job he had wanted since he was a child. The Coley siblings were always excited when the Hereford fieldman came through the gate. Those experiences led to he dream of working for the AHA. Tommy got the job and they moved to Tennessee. They found a home in Sewanee, a location that is a gateway to the eight states Tommy travels. This was key, as he has been on the road 260 days in a year.

Kim had been by his side, providing support and traveling with him when her schedule allows. Kim's favorite event has been hosting Hereford on the Mountain and hosting the many Hereford friends that have come to their home. Tommy is thankful to work in the Southeast Region. His job with the Hereford Association and the wonderful people he calls his best friends has been a blessing that has





sustained him and his family. If God makes a way, he has no plans to retire.

When Tommy is at home, which does not happen often, he loves going to Providence United Methodist Church and hearing Roy Hopkins preach and Kim sing a solo. They also love to take time to visit their children, 10 Grandchildren, and 2 Great Grandchildren, in Illinois, Iowa, and Texas.

I doubt Tommy remembers the first time I met him while he was clipping a heifer in Kansas City. I was impressed with his skill and hoped I could someday be like him. After knowing him for more than a decade, I still hope I can someday be more like Tommy and Kim. Their kind and generous nature touches all of those they meet. He has not only helped the producers in his region improve their herds, but he has also been a true friend.

Once again, congratulations to Tommy and Kim Coley, your THA family of the year.
