

Lauren Wingler of Christiana, Tennessee, was recently crowned the 2026 National Hereford Queen at the American Royal in Kansas City, Missouri. As National Hereford Queen, Wingler will serve as an ambassador for the American Hereford Association, promoting the Hereford breed and supporting junior members across the country. Her first official appearance was at the North American International Livestock Exposition in Louisville, Kentucky.

Wingler is the daughter of Russ and Sally Wingler and has more than 10 years of involvement with the Tennessee Junior Hereford Association and the National Junior Hereford Association. She exhibits cattle at the national level, has attended NJHA leadership conferences, and competed at multiple contests in the Junior National Hereford Expo. She is currently a freshman at the University of Tennessee at Martin, majoring in agricultural business, and is involved in the university's Cattlemen's and Farm Bureau Association.

Active in youth leadership, Wingler has participated in Tennessee 4-H, serves as a Tennessee Cattlemen's Association youth ambassador, and was president Lauren of the Tennessee Junior Hereford Association. She has also taken part in leadership conferences and contests at the VitaFerm® Junior National Hereford Expo.



"Serving as National Hereford Queen would allow me to give back to the industry that has shaped me, share the values and traditions of the Hereford breed and ensure a bright, sustainable future for agriculture and for the generations that follow," Wingler said.

Selected from five state queens, Wingler will attend major shows and sales throughout the year, assisting with ring presentations and award ceremonies. Supported by the National Hereford Women and the Hereford Youth Foundation of America, she will receive a \$10,000 scholarship at the conclusion of her reign to support her education.






Producer Spotlight DKM/Parker Bros.



DKM/Parker Bros. is our producer spotlight for this issue. The farm is located in Bradyville, Tennessee and operated by the David and Paula Parker family. Many THA members have memories of attending the Parker Labor Day Sale over the years. The farm continues to thrive and grow with the younger generation taking on new roles.

How did you get your start in the Hereford Industry / How long have you been in the Hereford/Beef cattle business?

I have been involved in the cattle business my entire life. Parker Bros., (Houston and Kenneth Parker) started in the Hereford business in 1942, when the first Hereford heifers were purchased from George Davis of Coffee County.

Describe your operation.

Today, our cow herd consists of more than 200 registered Hereford cattle along with 50 commercial cows, and the herd continues to expand each year. We




primarily calve in the spring, although we do have a small fall calving group. Over the years, we've found spring calving works best for our operation, allowing us to focus more on cattle once harvest season has ended.

On the farm, Paula and I mainly serve in an advisory role. Lynn Trail, Justin Parker,

and DJ Moore manage the day-to-day care of the cattle and crops. Lynn and DJ handle all AI work, while Angela Moore assists with record-keeping and paperwork.

What philosophy or standards do you use to build the genetic base of your herd?

We strive to produce well-rounded genetics, with performance and marketability being key priorities. Through the use of artificial insemination and embryo transfer, we continue to upgrade our herd.



What goals do you have for the future of your herd?

Our goal is to raise cattle that excel in our own operation and are also productive and profitable in our customers' herds.

How do you market your cattle?

Every three years, we host a production sale on the farm, offering cows, cow-calf pairs, and bred heifers. All of our steers are marketed through Parker Family Beef, a direct-to-consumer business we began in 2013. Angela attends local farmers' markets, our beef is sold at the local Farmers Co-op, and we also sell whole, half, and quarter beef directly from the farm.

What is a "favorite" memory from your time in the Hereford Industry?

One of my favorite memories was serving as president of the Tennessee Junior Polled Hereford Association

and participating in the first Junior National Show held in Nashville, Tennessee. Growing up in the show ring required hard work, but it was a wonderful experience. I've enjoyed countless memories showing cattle, attending shows, and traveling to sales across the country.

Do you have a special mentor(s) who has helped you in the cattle industry?

I've been fortunate to have many great mentors, but the most influential people in my Hereford journey have been my father, Kenneth Parker, and my uncle, Houston Parker. They were the ones who brought Hereford cattle to our farm, and that legacy remains a major part of my life today. Through the Hereford business, I've had the opportunity to travel throughout the United States and form lasting friendships. These memories and relationships are ones I will always cherish.

Industry Spotlight ProTrition Feed, LLC.



ProTrition Feeds was built with livestock producers at the center of every decision. By bringing together the feed manufacturing, nutrition expertise, and trusted brands of Tennessee Farmers Cooperative and Purina Animal Nutrition, ProTrition offers producers more choices, dependable products, and the local service they rely on. With operations across Tennessee and surrounding states, the company combines research-backed nutrition, experienced feed and herd health teams, and efficient manufacturing to help producers do what they do best—raise healthy, productive animals. Led by longtime cooperative leader Joe Huffine, ProTrition is focused on delivering consistent quality, practical solutions, and real value from the mill to the farm. To take a closer look at ProTrition's development and future, John Houston, Director of Business Services at ProTrition Feed, LLC, answers our Industry Spotlight Q&A for the Tennessee Hereford Newsletter, sharing insight into the company's approach, priorities, and what producers can expect moving forward.

What inspired the creation of ProTrition?

The creation of ProTrition allowed for the expansion of feed service throughout the southeast. It is particularly allowed for brand expansion in order to manufacture and market Co-op, Purina, Cumberland Mills and Triple Crown brands of feed. By combining efforts in manufacturing with Purina Animal Nutrition, we were able to become more efficient, providing farmers with high-quality products without large price increases.

How is the company structured?

ProTrition feed is a joint venture company owned by Tennessee Farmers Co-op and Land-O-Lakes Purina. It is governed by a 6 member board equally represented by TFC and LOL Purina. Currently, ProTrition employs around 175 people and is headquartered in LaVergne TN

What was the overall mission and vision for the development of ProTrition? How has that evolved since 2021?

The mission is simple – To grow our sales territory and to become more efficient in manufacturing feed. With the joint venture, ProTrition has management of four feed mills. Since 2021, we have updated manufacturing equipment in the mills and are now in the process of combining the Nashville mill with the other mills. In 2026, we will see all the tons manufactured in three mills rather than four. This effort will make the manufacturing process substantially more efficient.

What is the current footprint of the company?

For the Co-op and Cumberland Mills brand we sell all over the southeast, particularly in TN, VA, KY, NC, GA, AR, MS. The Co-op brand is sold only to cooperatives in these areas, while the Cumberland Mills brand is sold to Co-op's and independent dealers across the area. ProTrition distributes the Purina brand in TN and KY only to both Co-ops and independent dealers.

What products and services does ProTrition provide?

ProTrition is a full-line feed manufacturer and provider of all livestock and pet food for all species. This includes farm, pet, zoo, etc.

ProTrition received an AgTrack Grant in 2024 from TDA to build a feed mill in Rutherford County. What is the status of that project? Are there any plans to expand the current geographical reach or to build additional feed mills?

The mill being constructed will be next to the current LaVergne mill and will be a small mix mill to allow ProTrition to mix beef feed with ionophores outside the main mill. This will allow the main mill in LaVergne

to be ionophore free, thus allowing for the expansion of producing equine-related products. This will allow us to serve more customers with more products, adding value to all customers and providing a larger economic impact to the agriculture community.

In addition, a new state-of-the-art warehouse is being constructed on the LaVergne campus to provide better and more efficient distribution of ProTriton products.

How does your company give back to the agriculture community?

ProTriton is heavily involved in supporting FFA and 4-H activities. ProTriton has employees serving on both the FFA and 4-H Foundation boards. In addition, many of our employees are members of local Farm Bureau boards, Fair Boards, etc.

This past October, ProTriton promoted Breast Cancer awareness with a pink tag on Co-op and Cumberland Mills Feeds. For each ton sold, a contribution was made to the Susan B. Koman Foundation. The promotion yielded over \$7000 for breast cancer awareness. This is just a few examples of how ProTriton gives back to the community

What current industry trends/developments are driving product development?

The main trend is the loss of large farm acres – this drives research and product development shifts to products that smaller rural farms need. Such as poultry and small ruminant products, along with wildlife products. While we look at products for these market niches, it is important to note that ProTriton is unique by being owned by two cooperatives. This allows ProTriton to continue to also focus on the needs for full time producers, which are the






