
This was the largest spring sale to date with over 250 calves selling. Consignors participating in the sale were from TN, AL, IL & MS. A good group of buyers were actively bidding on all lots, but buyer demand was especially strong for the heavier cattle.

TLP manager, Darrell Ailshie, commended the breeders for the high quality of the Hereford cattle consigned to the sale and also for their continuing efforts to work together to market their cattle.

** This is average premium for Hereford calves sold compared to weekly average of all calves sold state wide. True premium compared to other Hereford calves selling in local barns would be significantly higher. Premiums shown for 700 and 800 pound yearlings, once again reflect the benefits of not selling right off the cow, but rather putting calves through a backgrounding phase.
