The Gary Preston Family, 2025 THA Family of the Year

One of the special traditions of the Tennessee Hereford Association is to recognize the Family of the Year.

The 2025 recipient is the Gary Preston family. Gary, who has dedicated his life to agriculture and the Hereford breed, is a graduate of Tullahoma Central High School and has been farming in Middle Tennessee for over 40 years.

Alongside his wife, Gail, to whom he has been married for 45 years. They have raised two children: Rhiannon (husband Daniel), and Bret (wife Stacey). They are also the proud grandparents of Lucas and Jacob, both of whom are actively involved in the Tennessee Junior Hereford Association and Coffee County 4–H. Following in their father's footsteps, Rhiannon and Brett were both involved in the Tennessee Junior Hereford Association and their local 4–H club while growing up.

Gary's journey with Hereford cattle began in the early 1980s, His brother-in-law Chris Anderson, influence him to purchased his first commercial Hereford. Shortly after, he acquired his first registered Hereford from Houston Parker. Over the

registered Hereford from Houston Parker. Over the

years, he expanded his herd by purchasing cattle from Walker Hereford Farm, Parker Bros, and High Ridge Farm.

He owns and leases 500 acres of farmland and manages a herd of approximately 100 head of cattle. The herd includes 50 registered Herefords and the rest are commercial Angus or baldies. Gary and his son, Bret, are providing most of the labor. The herd is managed to increase the bottom line, they produce and bale their own hay, supplement with commercial Tennessee Farmer's Co-op feed and distillery syrup from the nearby Jack Daniel's plant as needed.

When asked about choosing genetics for his herd, he replied "It's not too popular lately, but I like some Victor influence in my cows. I just think it helps in our environment. We are selling pounds, not names. That being said, my son Bret has been going the show calf route in selecting his genetics. He is breeding some of the registered cows with bulls selected with help from the Hopkins boys."

Preston farm sells most of their calves through the Tennessee Hereford influence sale in Columbia. The calves are weaned and then backgrounded to a



target weight of 700–900 pounds. They also sell some steers to friends for freezer beef and a limited number of heifers are sold private–treaty.

When asked about his favorite Hereford memories, Gary said, "When Bret was showing calves, we had a class winner and division runner-up at the Southeastern Region with a calf we had raised. Also, when my niece Lauren won the Tennessee Beef Expo was a good one. I also enjoy watching my grandsons and Lauren's daughters showing their calves."

Gary has several people that have influenced his decisions and provided guidance in the Hereford Industry. He says "Chris Anderson would always be first in this list, he and his family have been in the Hereford business a long time. Other breeders I respect their cattle and advice are: Norman Davis, David Parker, Johnny Woolfolk, and Eric Walker. Many years of experience in this group."

Gary has played a vital role in the Hereford Influence Sale in


Columbia, serving as the Tennessee Hereford Association Committee Chairman. His leadership and dedication extend beyond this role, as he has served on the board of directors for both the Tennessee Hereford Association and the Middle Tennessee Hereford Association. Additionally, he is an active member of the Tennessee Cattlemen's Association and currently serves on the Moore County Farm Bureau Board of Directors.

Beyond his passion for cattle, Gary enjoys spending time with his grandchildren, whether cheering them on at ball games or supporting them in cattle shows. In addition to his contributions to the agricultural industry, Gary dedicated over 40 years of service at AEDC Arnold Air Force Base in Tullahoma, Tennessee, working in maintenance and construction before finishing his career at the water treatment plant.

Tennessee Hereford Queen Q&A with Lauren Wingler

Can you tell us about yourself and your background?

My name is Lauren Wingler, and I'm a proud fourthgeneration Hereford breeder from Christiana, Tennessee. I grew up on my family's farm, Cedar Forest Farm, where we run a registered cow/calf operation.
